## Camping Information

📍 As we don't allocate camping sites, you can choose any vacant site. Please be mindful of the privacy of other guests and allow space for other guests to comfortably access shared Portaloo and Shower. Non potable water available from tap, no electricity.

## Glampings Information

🛏️ Bedding and linen is supplied, however please remember to bring towels.

🔑 There is a lock on Glampings which we provide with check-in information the day of arrival.

🐾 If you are bringing a Fur Baby, pets are allowed to sleep in the Glampings - if they are in a pet crate.

### Inside glamping we provide you with;

- hot water bottles that you can fill,- plenty of blankets and,
- rechargeable lamps (we can arrange to swap these for you on request, they generally last two nights).

### Outside glamping area is your own private;

- outdoor kitchenette,
- gas cooker, whistle kettle, utensils, cutlery, crockery, esky (BYO ice),
- camp chairs,
- fire pit (Seasonal), some fire cooking utensils and a lighter.

## Off-Grid & Access Information – Camping & Glamping



Limited phone range! If you aren't with Telstra or Optus, please let us know before you come as you may not be able to contact us when on site so we will need to make alternative arrangements of how you can contact us if needed.



Off-grid means no electricity. Generator, permitted times for campers are 10am – 11am and 2pm- 3pm, as tranquillity and comfort for all our guests is paramount. In cases where there are no other guests, generators can be used any time.



During permitted fire season, each site has its own fire pit. Wood is available to purchase on site. Kindling can be collected from the ground inside the camp area plantation trees. Please leave fallen wood in the native bush for habitat. **Please do not bring wood onto the property as it is a bio-security risk due to shot hole borer spread!**



Water is accessible from the campground tap and is clean but non potable (not for drinking).



A reminder to bring warm clothes and jackets all year round.



As it may not be convenient to 'pop to the shop' we have a 24hr Shop Trailer on site at the entry which is an honesty system and accepts (Cash and PayPal / Credit Card payments). Available for purchase are;

- Bottled water,
- Some basic non perishable food items (noodles, canned, jars, snacks).
- In permitted fire season, firewood is \$10 per bucket

**Between 19 September until 1 April & Easter Long Weekend, fires are not permitted meaning it is unlawful to light a fire (This may be varied at Local Government discretion).**



The local grocery store in Kukerin is 10 minutes drive away, open weekdays, closes early at 11am on Saturday and is closed on Sundays and Public Holidays). Lake Grace IGA Grocery Shop (30mins drive) is open 7 days but may not open Public Holidays, phone first to check. There are local Pubs, Cafes and Restaurants within 10-30 mins away). <https://www.candlelightcountryexperience.com/activities>



There is a shared campground warm bush shower and Portaloos onsite available to all campers in the grounds. There is a free off site dump point at Stubbs Park, 70 Bahrs Rd, Dumbleyung.



The campground is 6km of well maintained gravel road off the highway (2wd accessible) and is tucked away from traffic and keep the campground driveway discreet with only our guests having the rope gate access code to help ensure their privacy for stays (we will provide codes the morning of your arrival). The campground is very large but we only have one site per row of trees helping to maintain privacy, peace and tranquillity. Being remote we only get some local farming traffic however for additional peace of mind we have a security camera at the campground entry also.



If you are bringing a Fur Baby, we are in a rural setting and there are large animals and small animals nearby, and we need to keep both pets and farm animals safe. Are you aware that we allow pets only if they are on a leash at all times outside? If you're happy with this, it is a great place for walking pets!



## VISITOR SITE SAFETY GUIDELINES

Welcome to Candlelight Properties. We want you to enjoy your experience with the ability to undertake activities while ensuring you keep yourself and others safe.

By entering the property and campground at 1091 Candlelight Road North Kukerin WA, you agree to these safety practices in this short Work Health & Safety (WHS) Guideline & Site Induction for Visitors & Parents/Guardians of Children to provide awareness of possible hazards. We really appreciate your time to read this to best prepare for an enjoyable, safe experience. Thank you

**Introduction:** Candlelight Properties acknowledge that rural areas are a unique environment for visitors to enjoy. We believe this is an important component in creating the future link to the land. These Site Work Health & Safety Induction Guidelines outline potential hazards and controls to minimise risk to the safety of our family, visitors, fur friends, wildlife and nature. These guidelines help make Candlelight Properties a safe place to live and visit.

**Responsibilities:** Candlelight Properties have responsibilities regarding the safety and wellbeing of visitors to their properties. That is why these guidelines have been developed and we need your help in following these to keep everyone, including fur friends and nature safe! Visitors on Candlelight Properties are personally responsible for the supervision and safety of their children and visitors and must adhere to the following Candlelight Properties WHS guidelines. Visitors to Candlelight Properties must make themselves aware of potential hazards before accessing the area. Please only visit permitted areas and if unsure ask Candlelight Properties Management. Note: With the size and scale of surrounding broadacre farming and the potential for changing conditions, it is not practicable nor possible for Candlelight Properties Management to be aware of every potential hazard.

### **Simple things we can all do to help identify hazards and minimise Work Health & Safety Risks at Candlelight Properties, 1091 Candlelight Road North Kukerin WA:**

**PERMITTED AREAS:** See Site Map [www.candlelightcountryexperience.com/guestinformation](http://www.candlelightcountryexperience.com/guestinformation). Please do not enter stock paddocks or open gates other than the main entrance gate via the code provided. Gates will be opened during day light hours to the permitted activity areas (e.g. wildflower tracks). Ensure someone knows where you are, have a mobile phone with you, emergency contact details as well as adequate water and protective clothing.

**NON POWERED BIKES:** Parent/guardian must ensure the child/visitor rides at a safe speed for the terrain and conditions and wears a helmet at all times. Powered bikes (Motorcycles/ E-Scooters) are not permitted on the property for insurance reasons and comfort of other guests.

**ROAD VEHICLES:** Only registered vehicles (Department of Transport) are permitted on the property and must be insured. Road safety rules for 4WD vehicles on property designated tracks apply with the use of seatbelts, driving to conditions, noise, and personal protective equipment. Unless there is a manufacturers purpose built passenger seat, never let anyone, especially children, ride as passengers on bikes, or the trays/ trailers of vehicles. Registered motorcycles are permitted to access the camping area for camping purposes only. Motorcycle riding for leisure is not permitted anywhere on the property for the comfort of other guests and insurance purposes. Registered Motorcycles (Department of Transport) are permitted on surrounding public roads in accordance with WA Road Rules.

**SLIPS, TRIPS AND FALLS:** There are no dams in the permitted areas but are neighboring. Supervise children when they are around water that cannot be adequately fenced (e.g. water troughs) – remember that toddlers can drown in only a few centimetres of water. Any water body may be unsafe and contaminated. Do not climb farm infrastructure like silos as they can tip over. Look where you are walking, there are uneven, rocky and sandy ground surfaces.

**FARM ANIMALS, FUR FRIENDS, WILDLIFE & CRITTERS:** Ensure good hygiene practices to reduce the risk of contracting diseases or illnesses transmitted by animals. Do not enter any paddock to interact with animals, this can be done with the fence as your safety barrier, take notice of the animals body language to ensure they are happy to interact with you – be calm, move slowly, give the animal space, avoid loud noises, avoid their hind legs, wear safety boots/shoes – and remember that even good tempered stock can knock people over, bite, bunt, kick and cause injury. (E.g. a ram might be friendly but will still bunt you which may cause serious injury.) Types of farm animals you may encounter are; Horses, Sheep, Working Dogs, Chooks. Only feed animals food provided by or with permission from management as improper feeding can cause serious illness or death in stock. Children must be supervised around animals at all times. Wildlife like to keep to themselves however if you encounter them in the area; such as Kangaroos, foxes, rabbits, birds, bees, snakes, spiders, ants- keep your distance where possible, stay calm and slowly move away. Visiting dogs may be approved on property by management but must be kept on a lead or contained in a manner that will not cause harm to people, stock, wildlife or themselves. The greatest risk to visiting dogs is getting lost, baiting programs, dams and other animals.

**VEGETATION & ENVIRONMENT:** Please refrain from parking under overhanging tree branches, they have the potential to fall. There are prickly native plants and thistles on the property, their root system is important to our soil to stop it from eroding in the wind in dry months. Please wear appropriate footwear for the terrain. Feel free to admire and take photos of vegetation and flowers but please don't pick them. These areas are fenced to encourage vegetation growth and provide habitat to native animals. Be aware of weather conditions, if unsafe move to a protected area. There is the potential of exposure to dust, pollen and neighbouring farming operations which are out of our control. Please reduce your environmental footprint by not littering, taking your rubbish with you when you leave, ensuring you are self-contained (bring food, drinking water, toilet facility) and be aware there is no running water at the site. Generators are permitted for use on designated generator pads to reduce fire risk and during the times signposted at the entrance gate. Generators are only to be used while you are at the campsite to reduce fire risk from faults.

*Care and caution must be exercised by visitors on Candlelight Properties at all times. Candlelight Properties reserve the right to terminate visitor bookings in breach of these guidelines. In circumstances Candlelight Properties Management deem unsafe, the site may be evacuated at short notice and refund given to visitors.*

**The primary action to follow in a bushfire event is to EVACUATE**

**Controlled Evacuation** – *Early evacuation to allow Guests to gather their belongings prior to evacuating. Enact if bushfire is within 5 km or 5 hrs, DFES Watch & Act Warning or Signs of smoke from the nearby area.*

**Emergency Evacuation** – *Account for all Guests and immediately evacuate.*

*Do not connect caravans*

*Enact if bushfire is within 3 km or 3 hr or signs of smoke arising from the immediate surrounds.*

## **Option 1:**

Dumbleyung town centre or Stubbs Road when a designated Welfare Centre via North on Carwardine Road and west on Dumbleyung-Lake Grace Road.

## **Option 2:**

Kukurin town centre or designated Welfare Centre via South on Carwardine Road, east on Candlelight Road and east on Kukurin Road.

**On Catastrophic Fire Danger Rating days the Site will be closed and evacuated. Monitor the ABC Local Radio, 630 AM, or the DFES website for updates.**

Lower rope at Trailer Shop, proceed with caution and toot car horn 3 times when you see homestead to alert management. We may be at another location working on the farm so if unable to make contact at homestead, leave a note in the glamping exchange bucket in the Trailer Shop as we will check this at 4pm and can visit your site if request this in the note.

If you have pre-arranged extras packages we will always check with you before bringing them to your site on the day. If we receive no response by text message from you on the day, we assume and respect you would like privacy, and in the case of no response will refund pre-paid extras if we don't receive a reply and therefore can't deliver them.
